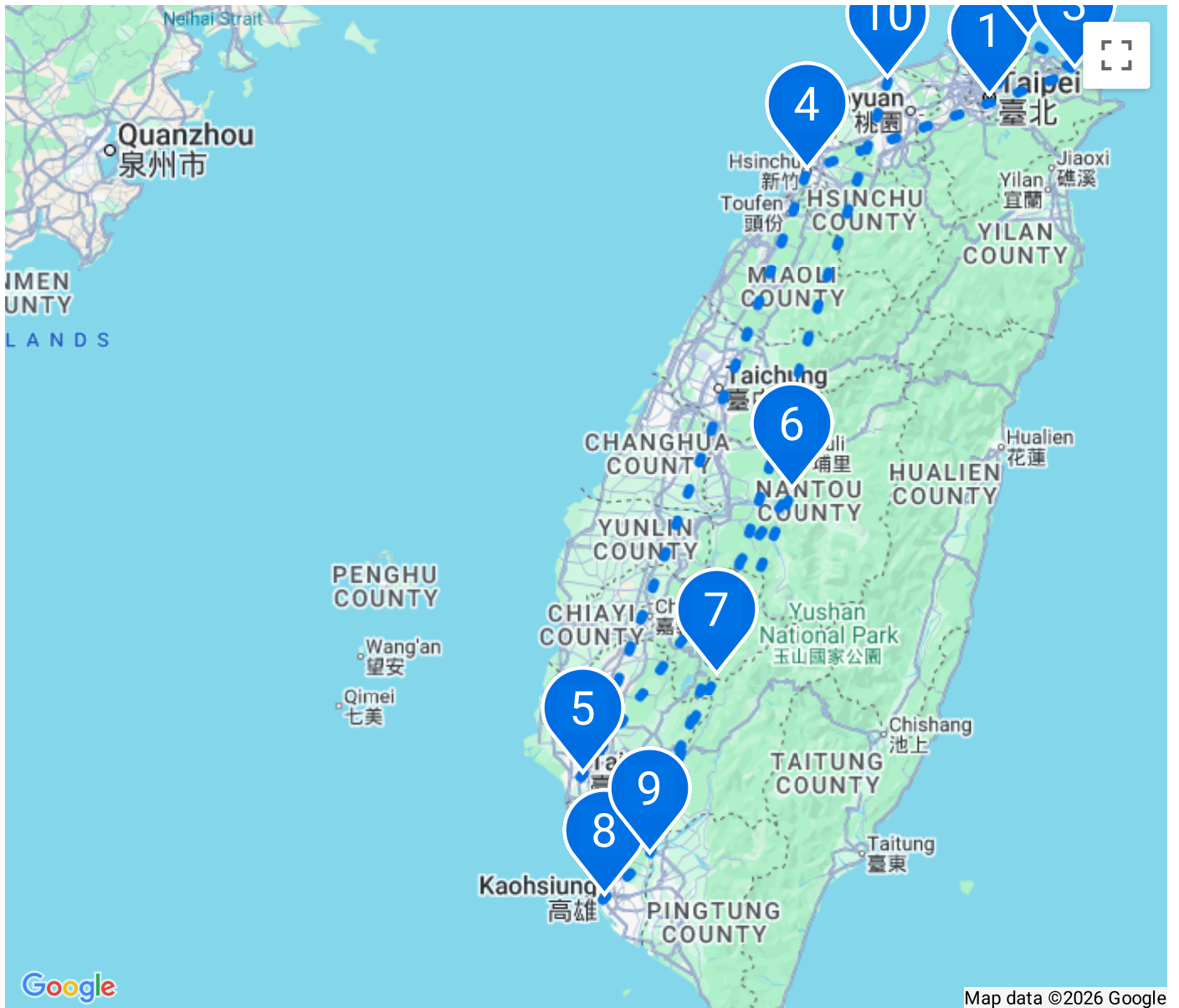

Travel Notes

Taipei

Arrival at Taipei airport and transfer to the city. Your visit will begin with the Ximending district, known for its lively atmosphere, pedestrian streets full of shops, restaurants, and trendy spots. It's the vibrant heart of Taipei's youth culture. In the afternoon, you'll head to the Shilin Night Market, the largest and most popular in the city, where you can taste local delicacies like bubble tea and the famous stinky tofu. Free time for dinner and overnight stay.

Parco Naturale di Yehliu

After a hearty breakfast, departure for a full day at Yehliu National Park, famous for its unique geological formations, such as the mushroom-shaped rocks and the famous "Queen's Head." The park offers a stunning panorama of cliffs and the sea. In the afternoon, return to Taipei and take a walk on Elephant Mountain (Xiangshan), a prime viewpoint that offers a spectacular view of the city and the **Taipei 101**, especially captivating at sunset. Free dinner and overnight stay.

Jiufen

Start the day with a typical breakfast, then depart for a full-day excursion to the enchanted town of Jiufen, a picturesque village that inspired the famous film "Spirited Away" by Hayao Miyazaki. Nestled between the mountains and overlooking the sea, Jiufen is known for its narrow cobbled streets, traditional tea houses, and panoramic ocean views. The nostalgic atmosphere and ancient charm of the village, with its colorful lanterns and markets, will transport you back in time. In the afternoon and evening, you'll have free time to explore the alleys and immerse yourself in the unique atmosphere of Jiufen. Free dinner and overnight stay.

Hsinchu

After a pleasant breakfast, departure for Hsinchu, where you will have the opportunity to interact with the Yamai indigenous tribe and learn about their traditions. The Yamai, like many other indigenous groups in Taiwan, have a rich and fascinating culture, deeply connected to nature, with customs passed down through generations. During the visit, you will discover their traditional rituals, crafts, and cultural practices that define their identity. In the evening, arrival in Taichung, one of Taiwan's largest and most dynamic cities. Free dinner and overnight stay.

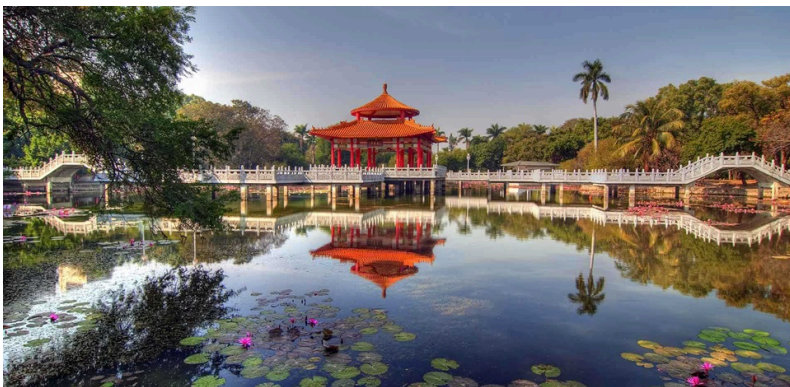


Tainan

After breakfast, explore Taichung and take part in a full-day guided tour of Tainan, the oldest city in Taiwan, where an expert guide will lead you through its historic temples and ancient sites. Tainan is famous for the Koxinga Temple, dedicated to the general who expelled the Dutch colonizers from Taiwan, and the Taoist Temple, one of the oldest on the island. During the visit, you'll also have the chance to wander through the city's historic streets, exploring traditional markets and admiring the architecture that tells centuries of history. Free dinner and overnight stay.

Lago Sole Luna

Start the day with a hearty breakfast before departing for a full-day excursion to Sun Moon Lake, one of Taiwan's most scenic spots. Located in the heart of the island, the lake gets its name from its unique shape resembling the sun and the moon: the western part of the lake represents the sun, while the eastern part resembles the moon. Surrounded by green mountains, the landscape reflected in the lake's waters creates a peaceful atmosphere. After enjoying a typical lunch, you will explore the area by minivan, taking in the natural beauty of the surroundings. Free dinner and overnight stay.

Alishan

After a refreshing breakfast, dedicate the entire day to exploring the Alishan Forest, one of Taiwan's most captivating natural destinations. This national park is renowned for its breathtaking mountain landscapes, dense forests of ancient cedar trees, and enchanting trails that wind through mist-shrouded valleys and peaks. Alishan Forest is also celebrated for its extraordinary sunrises: witnessing the sun rise above the Sea of Clouds is an unforgettable experience. Free time for dinner and overnight stay.

Kaohsiung

In the morning, after breakfast, an early wake-up call to witness the sunrise at Alishan. Following this, a private transfer to Kaohsiung, Taiwan's second-largest city and a significant cultural and commercial hub. Kaohsiung is renowned for its vibrant night markets, riverside parks, and contemporary architecture. Among its most iconic attractions are the Love River, where you can enjoy a stroll or a boat ride, and the Pier-2 Art Center, a former port area transformed into a lively art district. Dinner on your own and overnight stay.

Kaohsiung

After breakfast, begin your day exploring Kaohsiung, the vibrant metropolis of southern Taiwan. The visit includes the famous Dragon and Tiger Pagoda, located at the Lotus Pond. This iconic attraction consists of two colorful towers, which you enter through the open mouths of a dragon and a tiger, symbols of prosperity and good fortune according to local tradition. Continue with a stroll along the Love River, an ideal spot to relax, take a boat ride, or enjoy the peaceful riverside atmosphere, surrounded by cafes and green spaces. Finally, visit the Fo Guang Shan Monastery, the largest Buddhist monastery in Taiwan, famous for its imposing Buddha statue and the serene atmosphere that defines it. Free dinner and overnight stay.

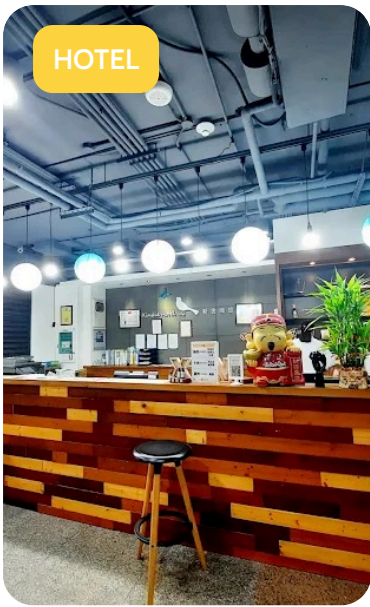

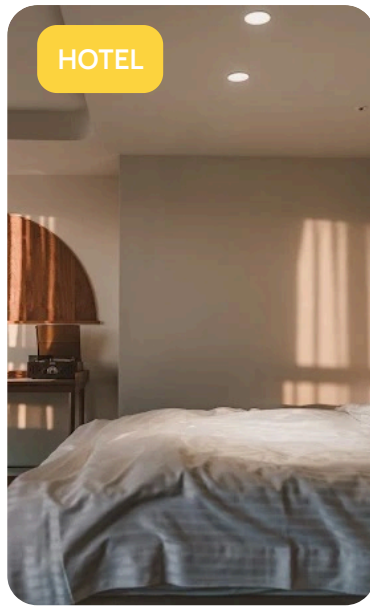

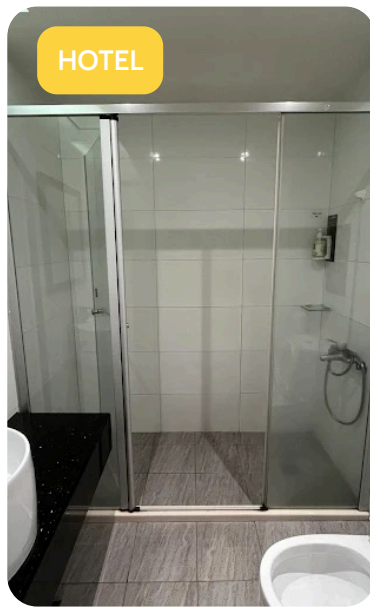
